Key conclusions

- New European green policies open opportunities for the rise of CE practices.
- SME's and construction operators need to be empowered with the necessary skills and competences to be able to adopt CE strategies on site.
- Topics such as Life Cycle Assessment (LCA), green certifications and eco-labels for materials should be addressed in VET programmes prioritizing digital tools.
- Construction operators' circular economy **competences** according to Green Growth's fieldwork:
 - Basic digital skills.
 - Overall awareness of the importance of keeping different waste streams separate.
 - Correct CDW management including waste segregation and disposal of materials to avoid contamination and preparation of demolition waste for further processing.
 - Awareness of possible hazardous components and substances both regarding OHS as well as removal of these substances from waste streams intended for recycling.
 - Environmental awareness.
 - Technical knowledge linked to the handling of specific materials.
 - Basic knowledge of the economic value of materials.
